

# Quality of Life Journal

### Mobility

- 0 Not mobile without assistance, medications do not help
- 1 Poorly mobile, difficulty getting up, hard to position to eliminate
- 2 Fair mobility, gets up with a little difficulty, stiff and/or a little weak
- 3 Good mobility

# Hydration

- 0 Requires IV fluids
- 2 Drinking less or more

### Urination

- 0 None
- 1 Abnormal urination/incontinence
- 2 Some abnormal urination/incontinence
- 3 Normal urination

### Nutrition

- 0 not eating, nausea/vomiting
- 1 Hand feeding, needs enticing
- 2 Picky, intermittent appetite
- 3 Good appetite

# 1 - Requires SQ fluids

3 - Normal water intake

### Defecation

- 0 None
- 1 Diarrhea or constipation
- 2 Some diarrhea or constipation
- 3 Normal stool/frequency

# Hygiene

- 0 Open wounds/tumors
- 1 Superficial skin lesions/itchy
- 2 Unkempt haircoat/dandruff
- 3 Normal hygiene

# Respiration

- 0 Labored breathing
- 1 Increased respiratory rate/effort
- 2 Episodes of increased rate/effort
- 3 Normal respiratory rate/effort

### Pain

- 0 Moderate to severe pain
- 1 Mild Pain
- 2 Occasional pain
- 3 No perceivable pain

# Mentation

- 0 Unconscious/obtunded/frequent seizures
- 1 Confusion/disorientation/anxiety/aggression
- 2 Occasional confusion/disorientation/anxiety/aggression
- 3 Normal mentation

## Interaction/Happiness

- 0 Hiding/Shying away from interaction
- 1 No interaction with family or pets
- 2 Some interaction/joy with family or pets
- 3 Normal interaction/joy with family or pets

## Scores:

- 26-30: Most likely your pet has an acceptable quality of life, monitor and report changes
- 17-25: Please report these changes/findings to Senior Paws as soon as possible for guidance
- < 17: Concern for poor quality of life and suffering, contact Senior Paws immediately for guidance
